## DEVICE SPECIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:

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Students need one of the following devices to access the learning path:

### Minimum specs on device:

- i3 or Ryzen 3 or better
- 4 GB RAM, recommend 8 GB.
- Athlon/Pentium processors are good alternatives

## FURTHER REQUIREMENTS:

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- Compulsory subjects (IGCSE & AS) for studying towards a degree:  
English Language, Afrikaans Additional Language, Mathematics (Extended)
- B-symbol on IGCSE Extended level is the recommended requirement for a student to continue with a subject at AS Level.
- C-symbol in IGCSE Mathematics is required to take Business in AS.
- Core and Extended examination options are available at the IGCSE level in Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, and Biology.  
*Note that an IGCSE subject taken at core cannot be taken at AS Level.*

- Physical Sciences accepted for university entry consist of both AS Chemistry and AS Physics.
- Ensure that the student's subject choices meet both the exemption requirements of Universities South Africa (USAF) also has the minimum entry requirements for course entry.
- To ensure that the student can apply to a university, ensure that they:
  - Understand and meet the faculty's minimum requirements for the field of study as shown in the "admission booklets" of different Universities.
  - Know what grades they need to achieve to gain entrance to their degree of choice.  
*Note that different departments at the same institution have different entry requirements.*

## EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS:

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Cambridge International Examinations are written either in **May/June** or **October/November**.

We recommend that our students write at Ecoltech as we are a registered Cambridge Examination Centre.
